NOTICE OF RACE

The Zoom⁸ European Championship will be held from April 12th to April 16th, 2022, in waters of Neusiedlersee, organized by the Yacht Club Mörbisch, Burgenländischer Yacht Club and the Zoom⁸ International Class Association

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Appendix P will apply.
- 1.4 Appendix T will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 (a) The regatta is open to boats of the Zoom⁸ class.
 - (b) All competitors shall be under the age of 20 on December 31st, 2022. Female competitors shall enter the Girl's European Championship and male competitors shall enter the Boy's European Championship.









- (c) All competitors shall be member of their national Zoom⁸ Class Association, according to Zoom⁸ Class Rules C.10.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online entry form found https://www.byc.at/jugend/regattentrainings/

In addition, the required fee shall be transferred in EURO to the following account:

Both entry and entry fee shall be received by March 14th 2022

3.3 Late entries will be accepted before the end of registration and are subject of an additional fee.

4 FEES

The entry fee is 220 EUR.

In case of late entry, there will be charged an additional fee of 50 EUR on top of the entry fee.

In case the event is cancelled due to Covid-19, a portion of the entry fee may not be refunded to pay for the fixed costs of running the regatta.

5 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

If a championship has more than 80 entries, the regatta may consist of a qualifying series and a final series.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration: April 11th, 2022 from 15:00 to 17:00 and April 12th, 2022 from 09:00 to 17:00.
- 6.2 Measurement and Inspection: April 12th, 2022 from 09:00 to 17:00.
- 6.3 A practice race is scheduled for April 12th, 2022
- 6.3 Dates of racing are from April 13th, 2022 until April 16rd, 2022
- 6.4 Number of races:

<u>Class</u>	<u>Number</u>	<u>Races per day</u>
Boy's	12	3
Girl's	12	3

One extra race per day may be sailed, provided that no class becomes more than one race ahead of schedule.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the practice race is 15:00.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 10:00.









7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall comply with the measurement checks as conducted by the Technical Committee. Details will be provided at registration.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 on April 12th, 2022 at the Registration desk at the latest.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- 9.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

10 THE COURSES

A trapezoid course will be used according to IZCA Standard SI.

The course will be presented in the Sailing Instructions.

The intended target time for each race will be 50 minutes.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

An International Jury in accordance with Appendix N will be appointed. Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12 SCORING

- 4 races (for each fleet, if a Qualifying and a Final series will be organised) are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When from 10 to 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

13 COACHES & SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches shall complete the online entry form for coaches found at www.byc.at/ before 15th March 2022.

Coaches and team support personnel shall provide the following documentation prior to completing registration formalities on site:

- Coach Entry Form
- Boat Driving License
- Evidence of valid third party insurance









14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

The overall winner of the Boy's and the Girl's Championship will be awarded the title "2022 Zoom8 Boy's European Champion" and "2022 Zoom8 Girl's European Champion", respectively.

Prizes will be awarded to the first six places in each championship.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

19 COVID-19 INFORMATION

The local present Covid-19 Rules & Restrictions issued by the Austrian Government will apply during the event. Please, follow the instructions when entering the event area. Furthermore, the Sailing Instructions will give information about Covid-19 rules and possible penalties in case of incidents observed.










APPENDIX A – Location of the Regatta Harbour
